What is the minimum order requirement for breakfast or brunch catering? Our Breakfast and Brunch Catering packages require a \$1,500 food minimum. A 20% production fee and applicable sales tax will be added to all onsite service events. For

Are disposable plates, utensils, and napkins included?

Yes! All catered breakfast and brunch events include premium disposable plates, utensils, and napkins. China rentals and upgraded service ware are available for an additional fee.

Is staffing included in my catering package?

Staffing is not automatically included. We offer chefs, service attendants, and bartenders for an additional charge. Labor costs will be quoted based on your final selections and guest count.

Platters and add-ons are designed to complement our breakfast and brunch menus. If you're interested in platters only, ask about our Platter package options.
